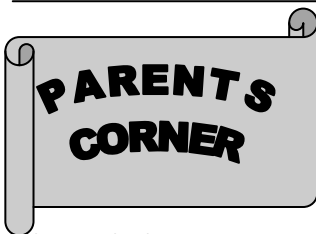

Orange class- Friday 2nd November.

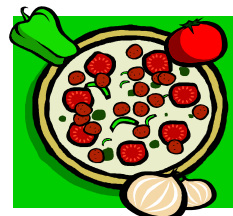
If you have time and would like to spend your morning with our lovely children please offer to help.
