(Message from Mrs Sanders)

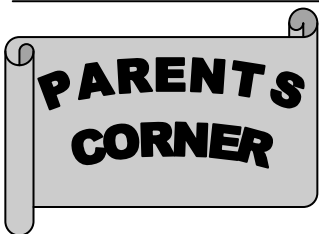
Don't let the children get under your feet this holiday! Please encourage them to **READ, READ, READ!!!**
