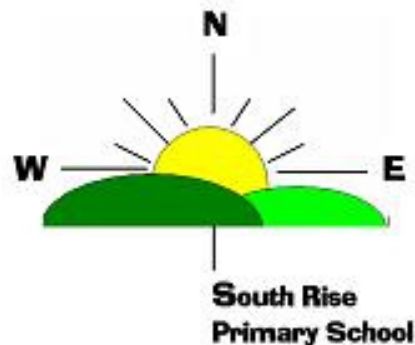

This was also a great success and thoroughly enjoyed by the children. I hope that the children were enthused enough to talk about the experiments they did through the week with their parents and carers.

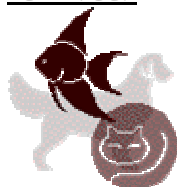
### SCHOOL LUNCHES
