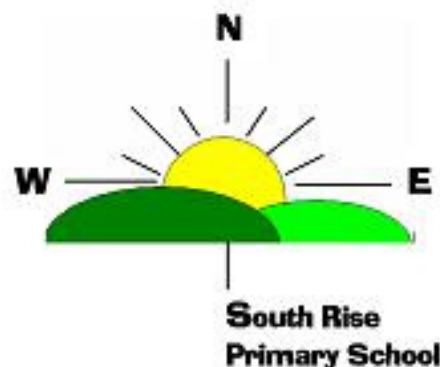

### **Reminders:**

#### **Head Lice**
