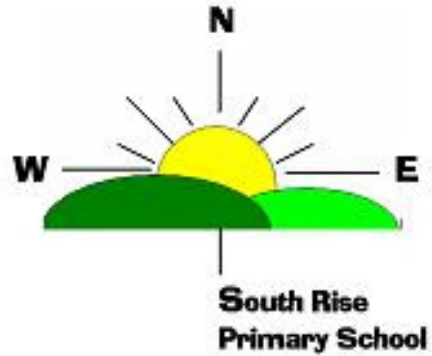

## School Rules

For this new Academic Year we will continue to be very strict on school uniform, punctuality, attendance and homework. **NO** jewellery will be tolerated, including earrings for boys or girls. No Mohican haircuts or shaved designs in hair or eyebrows of boys. Girls should not wear nail varnish, make-up, short skirts, high heels or have elaborate hairstyles. Black shoes must be worn. Head scarves worn for religious reasons must be plain white or blue. Gingham dresses to be blue and all clothes must be clearly labelled with the child's name (including coats, jumpers, hats, scarves, polo shirts, trousers, skirts, dresses, swimming costumes, towels, P.E. kits, school bags and pencil cases). All children are responsible for their own uniform. Children must arrive in school by 8.45 a.m. and be collected by 3.30 p.m.
