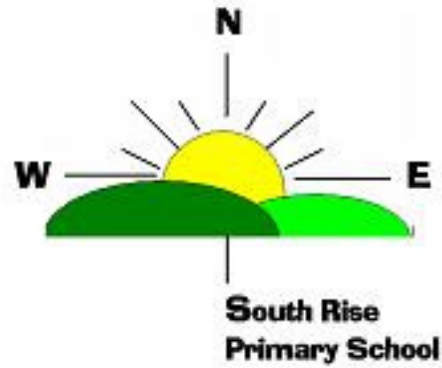

Shoelaces
