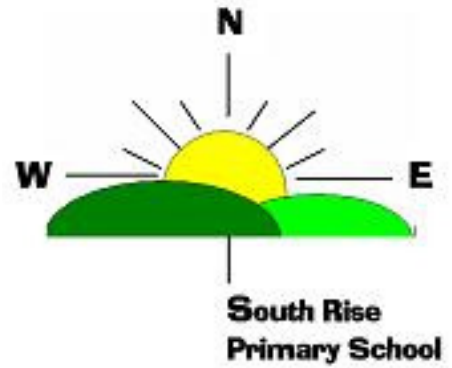

Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to start by thanking all of you for supporting our school in our initiative of keeping all children safe on school premises. Just to clarify the school's ruling about jewellery being worn by children, please adhere to the following:-

- **KS2 - No jewellery whatsoever**
- **FS & KS1 - If your child is wearing small stud earrings you are responsible for covering them with surgical tape for the duration of the school day.**
- **FS & KS1 - Please start to reduce the number of beads worn in hair as they are not allowed AT ALL IN KS2. Beads can be dangerous if swallowed, pushed up noses or pushed in ears! (we have seen this happen)**
- **KS2 - Beads worn in hair are not allowed**

### **Punctuality and Attendance**

Please send your child to school everyday and on time. Only keep your child at home if they are very ill or are vomiting and/or have diarrhoea. Please call the School to advise us of any child's absence.

### **Payment of Monies**

Dinner Money should be paid weekly in advance on a Monday morning in the KS2 hall from 8.45 am. Envelopes for dinner money are available from the office, at the moment, and should be clearly labelled with the child's name and class. All other monies may be paid into the School Office between 8.15 am - 4.30 pm Monday-Friday, please assist us by having the correct money.
