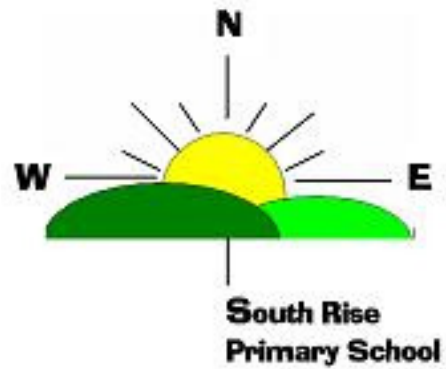

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome Back!

This is a very important year for South Rise; we will be consolidating the Primary Years Programme Unit of Inquiry. We will be evaluating the impact of all the Intervention Programmes we currently run in South Rise, including Rise and Shine Club and the Saturday School, on our Students academic progress. Towards the end of this Academic Year we are also expecting a visit from Ofsted and your collaboration is crucial in improving the outcome for our children. You can support the School by ensuring your children arrive at school on time, **doors open 8.45am, Registration 8.55am, they must consistently do their homework - every night - and they must come to school equipped with their learning tools: reading book, reading record, pencil case and P.E. kit.**

School Uniform

Please ensure your child's/children's names are on all items of School Uniform, jumpers, t-shirts, coats, hats, school bags and pencil cases. This year **all children must use South Rise Book bags; these are on sale in the School Office at £3 each. South Rise pencil cases are also for sale at £2 each. Children in Years 1-6 will be provided with a South Rise P.E. kit bag.**

Mobile Phones

When entering the School Premises, you are requested not to use your mobile phone as we want you to concentrate on your children and their day's news when you are collecting them and dropping them off.
